INTRODUCTION

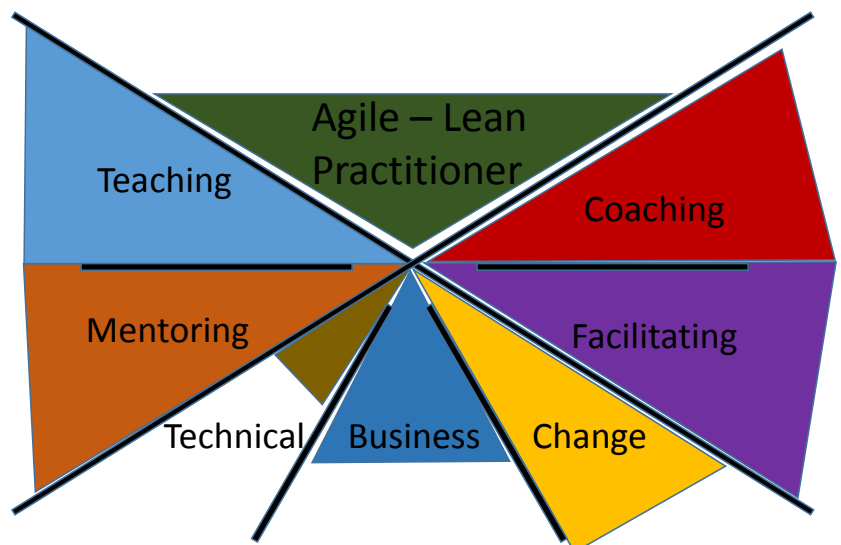
